### TEARFUND UPDATE from J Ball

Duncan and I recently enjoyed a delicious brunch courtesy of Tearfund. We met with some Tearfund staff and other supporters at an eatery at Trent Bridge, Nottingham. We had good views across the Trent on a lovely sunny morning.

It was a really interesting and informative time, hearing first-hand about Tearfund's work. We had a live Zoom link with a Tearfund worker in Haiti describing some amazing work they are doing there with plastic recycling. Much of the plastic is blocking waterways and ends up in the Caribbean. We were able to ask questions and saw some of the backpacks the waste is used to make. Their achievements are all the more remarkable when you realise Haiti has recently suffered another earthquake, the assassination of the president and much gang violence! Tearfund is also working hard with the suppliers of the single use plastic, mainly Coca Cola, Pepsi, Nestle and Unilever, to address the other end of the problem.

Much conversation also centred on the COP 26 climate change talks happening in Glasgow in November. This is a huge focus for prayer and lobbying and we will be getting daily updates for prayer from Jack Wakefield who will be there in person. He was the speaker we used when we had the Tearfund Church and Climate service in Greetham in September.

During COP 26 we will be providing prayer stations in the RAF chapel at Cottesmore to help you pray for the climate crisis and there will be plenty of information about the work of Tearfund to encourage your prayers. Please do come and take a look ........... and PRAY!
